Who we are

The Society is a non-profit-making voluntary organisation existing to further local interests in amateur horticulture generally within the local community by means of talks, visits and an annual flower show and fête.

Information We Collect

Members' contact details - Name, Address, telephone number, email address, taken from the membership joining form or provided voluntarily by the member subsequent to joining the Society.

How We Use and Protect Your Personal Data

Personal data is used for the sole purpose of disseminating information on the Society's activities (talks, visits, newsletters, meetings, flower shows, subscriptions and membership cards) to its members, using email, telephone, postal communications and door-to door deliveries, as appropriate. We will never include individual's contact details on our web site without their explicit permission to do so.

We will never disclose, share or sell your data to a third party organisation without your consent, unless required to do so by law.

The Society takes all reasonable precautions against illegal attempts to obtain members' details by use of masking, passwords, encryption, hidden folders etc., as appropriate.

A list of members' names appears annually in the Flower Show Schedule, distributed locally before each show. A member may choose not to be included in the list on joining the Society or subsequently by giving up to 28 days written notice to the Schedule editor by February 1st of each year, before the Schedule is printed.

How Long Information is retained

Members' contact details are recorded from the membership joining form when a member joins the Society and are retained only until that member voluntarily leaves The Society or dies.
